Some of these are variable year-on-year as it depends where events and meetings are held. Government core funding was slightly increased and gaming grant emailed stable. Healthy balance sheet with reserves that have been accumulated for the replacement of the HJSC roof. In November 2019 the Board approved a 2019-2020 budget that allowed for a \$70k deficit. With COVID-19 this budget is no longer valid and the deficit will be larger. Staff, Finance and Audit Committee and the Board are working hard to manage costs to mitigate the impact as much as possible.
