# HARRY JEROME SPORT CENTRE COVID-19 REMINDERS AND MEASURES

Effective January 6, 2022

- As per the current *Public Health Order on Gatherings and Events*, indoor events and venues and adult indoor sport/recreation must be limited to 50% of the occupancy of the space. **During this period, the total maximum occupancy of HJSC at any single time will be 200 individuals.** Maximum occupancy limits will be posted in the restrooms and office spaces.
- **All users must complete a health screening questionnaire on the [Province of BC COVID-19 app](#) before entering the facility.** Individuals displaying symptoms of COVID-19 will not be permitted to enter HJSC and may be asked to leave the facility.
- **Proof of vaccination will be required from the following individuals:**
  - Sport participants age 22 years and over.
  - Coaches, organisers, and volunteers leading youth sport programs for participants age 21 years or younger.
  - Any non-participating individuals or spectators age 12 years and over.**Any individual refusing to show proof of vaccination will not be permitted to enter HJSC and may face permanent exclusion.**
- **Spectators are not encouraged and may be asked to leave by program organisers.** Any spectators age 12 years or over must show proof of vaccination.
- **Signage will be posted throughout HJSC with reminders to physical distance, wear masks, and proof of vaccination requirements.** Please remain at a minimum of 2 metres distance from other individuals at all times, apart from while participating on the field of play.
- **All individuals age 5+ years must wear masks at all times apart from while participating on the field of play.** Please note: you must bring your own mask. There are no masks available at the facility.
- **Cleaning products will be made available** in the court area for patrons to use as required. There will be minimal shared equipment provided on court. No balls will be provided by the facility.
- **Enhanced cleaning protocols will be implemented** including twice daily cleaning of high traffic touchpoints including bathrooms, shared touchpoints, court items, and equipment.
- **HJSC staff will follow mask and protective personal equipment guidelines** while undertaking their work and interacting with the public.
- The [Communicable Disease Plan for HJSC](#) will be followed with enhancements outlined above.
