

## Guiding Principle: All athletes have the right to be coached by an NCCP Certified coach!

Volleyball BC (VBC) and Volleyball Canada's (VC) Coach Requirements are to ensure that all coaches participating in VBC or VC club events have the knowledge and training necessary to provide every athlete with a safe, inclusive and responsible sport experience.

All coaches have the responsibility to:

- Have the required training to provide an environment that is physically, mentally, emotionally and socially safe for all athletes and participants.
- Have the required training to be able to provide a responsible learning environment that incorporates VC's teaching methodologies, technical guidelines and long-term athlete development principles.
- Ensure that all training is current and updated as required, to be able to provide a safe and responsible sport experience for all.

14U 15U	1st Year	The Big 4 Mandatory Requirements <u>Foundations of Volleyball</u> <u>**Development Coach</u> <u>Workshop**</u>	<ul> <li>Div. 1 &amp;2 or "AA" Head Coaches that are coaching in the Development Stream (14U-16U) for the 1<sup>st</sup> time are required to become a "Trained" Development Coach, by taking the Development Coach Workshop (in addition to the other requirements).</li> <li>The Development Coach Workshop is designed to introduce the game of volleyball and basic methodology to the introductory coach working with "Train to Train" athletes (13-16 age groups).</li> </ul>

17U 18U	1st Year	The Big 4 Mandatory Requirements <u>Foundations of Volleyball</u> <u>Development Coach Certified</u> <u>**Advanced Development Coach</u> <u>Workshop**</u>	<ul> <li>Div. 1 &amp; 2 Head Coaches that are coaching in the Advanced Development Stream (17U-18U) for the 1<sup>st</sup> time are required to become a "Trained" Advanced Development Coach, by taking the Advanced Development Coach Workshop (in addition to the other requirements).</li> <li>The Advanced Development Coach Workshop is designed for coaches working with athletes in the "Learn to Compete" LTAD (17U-18U). The Workshop expands on the knowledge and skills learned in the Development Coach context and applies advanced training methods. Additionally it provides learning experiences to assist in applying proven methods of coach intervention and practice design. Coaching abilities will be assessed throughout the course in a cooperative peer lead environment.</li> </ul>			

17U	3rd	The Big 4 Mandatory Requirements <u>Foundations of Volleyball</u>	*	Div. 1 & 2 or "AA" Head Coaches that are coaching in the Advanced Development Stream (17U-18U) for the 3rd plus time, are required to become a <b>Certified Advanced Development Coach</b> .
18U	+ Year	Development Coach Certified <u>Advanced Development Coach</u> <u>Workshop</u> <u>**Advanced Development Coach</u> <u>Certified**</u>	*	To be certified, Advanced Development coaches must successfully complete seven (7) evaluation requirements (multisport and volleyball-specific), which are summarized here.

## **IMPORTANT NOTES:**

- 1. Missing Mandatory Requirements (The Big 4) will result in a \$250 sanction and disqualification from participating at Provincials. Missing Coaching Requirements (Head Coaches), will result in a \$250 sanction.
- 2. All Coach Requirements must be met <u>regardless</u> of attendance at provincials to ensure all athletes have a "coach with the knowledge and training to provide a safe, inclusive and responsible sport experience".
- 3. Any Head Coach participating at Volleyball Canada's Nationals, needs to complete Div. 1&2/"AA" requirements.
- 4. Head Coaches who have achieved Certified status in their appropriate context are still required to complete the mandatory requirements in Section A (above) and maintain Active status in the NCCP Locker.
